Where members choose to pay their subscription on an annual basis and by the due date, a <u>10% discount</u> will apply.

Ways to pay your Union Fees

1. Bank Account - Direct debit from a bank account or credit union account. This facility is not available on Passbook Accounts.

Direct debiting is the simplest, most secure and preferred method of payment. The advantage of direct debiting is that the employer will not have the power to control your financial membership of your union. This ensures that the ASU is a strong and progressive union able to meet the challenge. Some financial institutions may charge a fee for this service. Please check this with your financial institution.

Your union does not have direct access to your account. Your financial institution can only debit the standard subscription amount from your account. Members who have queries about how direct debits operate should call our Member Services Centre on (08) 9427 7777.

2. Credit Card - Payment of union subscriptions may be made by direct debit from your Visa Card or MasterCard.

3. Invoice - Subscriptions may also be paid in advance by direct deposit, cheque or credit card on a quarterly or annual basis on receipt of an account. The account must be settled promptly.

Resignation from the union

- A member may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary, in accordance with requirements of the rules and the Act.
- A notice of resignation takes effect when a member ceases to be eligible for membership of the union or two weeks after the notice has been received at the union office.
- Any member resigning shall be liable for the payment of all subscriptions, fines and levies owing to the union under the rules at the date of resigning.

Financial obligations arising from membership

Members shall pay subscriptions fixed in the Branch rules in accordance with National Rules 18 (Subscriptions). Members shall pay any levies imposed in accordance with National Rule 22 (Levies) and the Branch rules, and any fines imposed in accordance with national Rule 36 (Member Misconduct) and the Branch Rules.



Our Union has coverage of workers in six divisions:

Administrative, Clerical and Customer Services Energy and IT Local Government Municipal Employees Social and Community Services Transport

If you work in an industry under our coverage, it is your right to join the ASU.

Joining our Union means real benefits.

Advice and Assistance:

Our Member Services Centre is there for you to call when you have questions about your work. It could be to question if your payroll department is correctly calculating your pay or to ask about conditions you might be entitled to such as when you are due to take long service leave or how much annual leave you should be entitled to. It could also be to talk through how to deal with an issue in your workplace or to get assistance when your employer is being difficult, such as returning to work from maternity leave. Sometimes the query needs a little research or advice from an Industrial Officer but, more often than not, a ten minute phone call will help you.

Protection for your journey to and from work (or out to get lunch):

Many years ago, employers in Western Australia were required to include workers' journeys to and from work. When that was abolished by the State Government, ASU (and other WA Unions) decided to provide protection that covers your absence from work should you have an accident on your journey to or from work, whether you walk, ride, catch public transport or drive.
